Reported by the Moultrie News (March 14, 2001):

“Members of the Fourth Landing Support Battalion Marine Reserve unit gave the Isle of Palms a hand this past weekend while gaining valuable training experience. The Marine put in place a material known as Mobi-Mat at the 9th Avenue Beach access, from the roadway to the beach, providing a safe footpath for beach goers.”

“Recently the City of Isle of Palms paid 45,000 USD for a wooden beach access. The Mobi-Mat material proved much expensive, costing 15 000 USD for two paths to be set.”

“According to David Mobley, the Project Manager, the Mobi-Mat will stabilize the soil beneath the trail and allow for less erosion. This material is less evasive and expensive than building a wooden walkway.”
